Do not stare at me because I am dark, because I am darkened by the sun. - *Song of Songs 1:6*

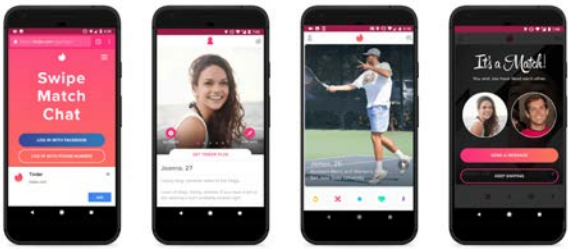
Q: *What is the primary source of insecurity in your relationship?*
